- [How to Share Access to Google Tag Manager \(GTM\)](#)

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1. Log in to Google Tag Manager

Go to [Google Tag Manager](#) and log in with your account.

2. Select the Appropriate Account and Container

Once logged in, ensure you select the correct **GTM account** and **container** that you want to share access to.

3. Navigate to Admin Panel

In the GTM dashboard, look at the upper-left corner and select the **three-dots-button**.

4. Go to User Management

Click on **User Management**.

5. Add New User

In the User Management panel, click on the blue **+** button in the upper-right corner and select **Add Users**.

6. Enter the Email Address

In the email field, enter **tech@point2web.com**.

7. Set Permissions

For your agency to create and edit tags, assign the following permissions:

Container Permissions: Select **Edit** and **Publish**. This allows your agency to create, modify, and publish tags.
